Terrorist attacks kill dozens as British PM visits Pakistan

More than 40 people have been killed in two deadly attacks, where a suicide bomber killed more than 20 people at a checkpoint near a Shiite Muslim mosque in the south-western city of Quetta, and a car bombing killed 17 in the north-west city of Peshawar. Covered from head to foot in padded protective gear, but with his extremities still dangerously exposed, this Afghan bomb disposal expert took his life in his hands to defuse this suicide bomber's explosive vest. India decline world's largest network to detect nuclear activities

This network has cost one billion dollars. It has been funded by 183 countries. And it has one agenda - to detect within minutes nuclear explosions that are conducted on land, air or even under the sea. India has not signed up. So the network, referred to as Comprehensive Test Ban Treaty Organisation monitoring network will rely on monitoring stations in Pakistan, Nepal and Sri Lanka to snoop on nuclear activity in India.
