China opens world's highest airport

China has begun flight operations at the world's highest civilian airport in a bid to boost tourism and tighten political control over the country's restive west. At an elevation of 4,411 meters above sea level, Daocheng Yading Airport replaces the previous champion, Bangda Airport in the Tibet Autonomous Region, which sits at 4,334 meters. [Read more](#)

The main airport serving the central Norwegian city of Trondheim, *Værnes Lufthavn*, was evacuated Monday morning and later closed, after a telephone caller speaking in the local Trønder dialect warned of a bomb, possibly located in the terminal building. A baby has been killed in an accident after his mother rested his carrier on an airport baggage carousel. The special conveyor belt, reserved for larger items, was not moving at the time but was then switched on at Alicante-Elche Airport in Spain. This multifactor real-time biometric scanning tech could have prevented the Navy Yard shootings

A new multifactor biometric system from FST21 that identifies known approved people as they walk up to a building or access point could have prevented something like the Navy Yard shootings that took the lives of 13 people in Washington. "There is a need to find a new paradigm for security and convenience," FST21's chief executive Aharon Farkash — a former general in Israel's military intelligence arm — told me today. Bar Harbor bomb threat causes evacuation of Cottage Street businesses

A bomb threat at the Rite Aid Pharmacy at 34 Cottage St. Wednesday caused the evacuation of neighboring businesses, according to a local police and fire dispatcher. A Rite Aid pharmacy employee reported the bomb threat to Bar Harbor police shortly

Group releases 'suspicious activity reports' on Americans gathered by terrorism officials

Two men of Middle Eastern descent were reported buying pallets of water at a grocery store. A police sergeant reported concern about a doctor "who is very unfriendly." And photographers of all races and nationalities have been reported taking snapshots of post offices, bridges, dams and other structures. The American Civil Liberties Union and several other groups released 1,800 "suspicious activity reports" saying they show the inner-workings of a domestic surveillance program that is sweeping up innocent Americans and forever placing their names in a counterterrorism database.
