Escaped terrorist suspect Mohammed Ahmed Mohamed 'is linked to Olympic Games bomb plot'

Fugitive terrorism suspect Mohammed Ahmed Mohamed may have been linked to a plot to bomb the London Olympics and stage a Westgate-style massacre at Eton College, security officials believe. The 27-year-old, who is on the run after slipping out of a mosque disguised in a burka, is closely associated with an Al Shabaab sleeper cell known as the London Boys. [Read more](#)



Days after Beijing attack, China talks cooperation on terrorism

Days after a terrorist attack at the historic Tiananmen Square in the heart of Beijing, China for the first time expressed strong support for "counter-terrorism" cooperation with India and Russia at a meeting here Sunday. Wang reportedly said that the attack at Tiananmen Square involved "jehadist elements".
