

Explosion at LA airport terminal delays flights

Authorities are investigating an explosion at a Los Angeles International Airport terminal that caused up to four flights to be delayed. Airport police Sgt. Karla Ortiz said the explosion at Terminal 2 was reported around 7 p.m. Sunday. She said she didn't have immediate information on what caused the blast, or how severe it was, and referred questions to the FBI which is handling the investigation. [Read more](#)



Cable theft delays flights at Johannesburg airport

A number of flights were delayed at Johannesburg international airport on Sunday after an attempted cable theft left planes unable to refuel, an airport official said. Three power cables were "severely damaged" in the attempted robbery just outside the perimeter of OR Tambo Airport, Airports Company South Africa (ACSA) spokeswoman Unathi Batyashe-Fillis was quoted as saying by Sapa news agency. Tri-Cities Airport security takes over for TSA

Starting Jan. 1, Tri-Cities Airport security officers will take over making sure people who have not been screened can't slip into a secure area at the Pasco airport. Airport Director Ron Foraker told Port of Pasco commissioners last week that Transportation Security Administration officers will no longer be monitoring the doorway between the unscreened area of the airport terminal and the secured waiting area. AN easyJet passenger plane was diverted to Stansted Airport following a security alert. The plane which had 151 passengers and six crew members on board was travelling from Hamburg to Luton when the security alert happened. Indian airlines to consider investing in new tech for passengers: Study

Indian airlines, which have been reluctant to invest in new technologies to improve passenger facilities primarily due to resource crunch, should start using latest IT solutions to benefit passengers, a recent study has found. According to the study carried out by aviation consultancy firm CAPA and prominent aviation IT solution provider SITA, facilities like provision of WIFI on-board planes, greater usage of mobile technology, self-check in kiosks and biometrics and e-passports for border protection should be introduced in newly-modernised airports in India. Four men have been arrested in London in a counter-terrorism operation, the Metropolitan Police have said. Scotland Yard said they were held under the Terrorism Act 2000 on suspicion of the commission, preparation or instigation of acts of terrorism. North Korea on Saturday issued a fresh warning of an "all-out war", urging the United States to stop military drills and what it described as "nuclear blackmail". In a thinly veiled threat to strike the United States, the North's National Defence Commission (NDC), chaired by leader Kim Jong-Un, said the US government must withdraw its policy of hostility against the North if it wants peace on both the Korean peninsula and the "US mainland".
