## Envelope With Unknown Substance At Google Building Determined To Be Safe



Authorities in Mountain View including a hazardous materials team investigated an envelope with an unknown substance found at a Google building Tuesday afternoon, but determined the substance to be harmless. The envelope was discovered at a building owned by Google located on the 2600 block of Casey Avenue in Mountain View, according to Mountain View Fire officials. Mountain View Fire confirmed that units were on the scene investigating at 3:30 p.m., but said that no evacuations had been ordered so far. Mountain View Police tweeted about the incident at about 3:50 p.m.

## Top Hezbollah Financier Extradited to US



A top Hezbollah financier was extradited to the U.S. from Paraguay to [face charges](#) of a \$1.4 million drug money laundering scheme. At the [request of the U.S. government](#), Nader Mohammad Farhat was arrested in May 2018 in the Ciudad del Este, called the "Triple Frontier" since the area borders Paraguay, Brazil and Argentina. He is reportedly a member of a Hezbollah division involved in massive international illegal financing of the terror group. At the time of his arrest, \$1.4 million in cash was found in his home as well as documents that reportedly confirm his money laundering through his money service business, Unique SA. Farhat was also wanted in Paraguay for similar crimes.

## Explosives Sent to Paris in Iranian Diplomatic Packages



The explosives for a [planned attack](#) on an Iranian opposition group convention outside Paris were brought into the country in Iranian diplomatic packages sent on a civilian airliner. This shocking new detail was revealed by an intelligence source quoted by *Independent in Arabic*, a British newspaper. The attack, which was thwarted by European officials, was in motion and set to happen at the annual massive gathering of Iranian [opposition supporters](#), a group in exile which seeks to end Shi'ite Muslim clerical rule in Iran. The [rally](#) took place in June 2018 and was attended by thousands including President Trump's National Security Adviser John Bolton and former lawyer Rudy Giuliani as well as several former European and Arab ministers. The intelligence sourced reported that diplomatic packages with half a ton of TATP explosives were checked in on June 22, 2018 on a civilian Airbus plane from Tehran to Austria carrying 240 passengers.

## Singapore Airlines, Malaysia Airlines sign deal to expand codeshare ties

National carriers [Singapore Airlines](#) (SIA) and Malaysia Airlines (MAS) on Thursday (Jun 27) signed a preliminary agreement that could see them "significantly" expand codeshare flights. Under the terms of the memorandum of understanding, SIA and MAS will explore a "wide-ranging strategic partnership" to build on their existing codeshare agreement, the airlines said. This could include a significant expansion of codeshare flights beyond Singapore-Malaysia routes, as well as enhancements on the frequent flyer programme front and potential cooperation in cargo and maintenance services. A formal agreement is expected to be finalised in the coming months, subject to regulatory approvals, and will include SIA subsidiaries [SilkAir](#) and [Scoot](#) as well as MAS' sister airline Firefly.



## Gunman wounds two, including imam, in French mosque shooting

A gunman opened fire outside a mosque in northwestern France on Thursday (Jun 27), wounding the local imam and another person, before fleeing the scene and later being found dead, officials said. It was not immediately clear what motivated the incident in the port city of Brest in Brittany, but Interior Minister Christophe Castaner said he had issued orders to increase security measures around places of worship across France.



## Muslim Women Draw From Rosa Parks to Defy Burkini Ban

Fresh on the heels of [Alexandra Ocasio-Cortez](#) leaning on the intersectionality of concentration camps and migrant detention centers, French women are drawing on their own parallels between iconic civil rights leader Rosa Parks and their own [defiance against](#) France's burkini ban. The women, part of a campaign which was launched in the French city of Grenoble by a group called the Citizen Alliance, aims to defy the ban on wearing burkinis which are forbidden at many pools and beaches in France. They say they've been inspired by Rosa Parks who, in 1955, became famous for refusing to give up her seat on a Montgomery, Alabama bus for white passengers when order by the bus driver to do so.



## The Struggle to Turn Your Face Into Secure Travel ID

The global travel industry is looking to replace your paper tickets and security documents with your biometric data in an effort to ease gridlock. The International Civil Aviation Organization, the UN's aviation body, met last week in Montreal to discuss ways to bridge the gulf between physical and digital travel documents. At least 53 biometric systems are used by the industry for everything from airline boarding to hotel check-in, according to the World Travel & Tourism Council. Each is typically unique to a particular venue. British Airways' boarding gates in New York, Los Angeles, London and Orlando, for instance, use facial recognition; the airline says that more than 3 million domestic UK passengers have flown with the system. Clear, a New York-based private security screening company, uses iris and fingerprint scans to move passengers through security checks. The current lack of global standards frustrates achievement of a seamless journey from airport curb to destination city.
