2 US Sailors Against 20 ISIS Fighters



Two US sailors in Iraq single-handedly fought off 20 ISIS fighters and protected their fellow troops at the same time from oncoming fire. Christopher Greene and Travis Holland, both explosive ordnance disposal technicians based in California, led a nighttime raid on a remote underground ISIS hideout in the Anbar province. Both were awarded the Bronze Star, Military.com reported. The raid took place on September 18, 2018. US sailors Greene and Holland were deployed to Iraq and assigned to the Special Operations Task Force-West. The unit traveled by helicopter to the ISIS headquarters hide out. Greene led the team in, clearing the cave complex of explosive threats. However, in the process, the unit was met by 15 to 20 ISIS fighters who had barricaded themselves inside.

Toronto Church to Host Event Honoring Terrorist



A Toronto church is hosting an event by a Palestinian youth group that honors brutal terrorists. Trinity-St. Paul's United Church is "provid[ing] a space" for the Ghassan Kanafani Resistance Arts Scholarship Launch being held by the Palestinian Youth Movement (PYM), reported *The Jerusalem Post*. Kanafani was the spokesman for the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine (PFLP) at the time the terrorist group claimed responsibility for the massacre of Lod (now Ben Gurion) Airport in Israel in which 26 civilians were killed, including one Canadian and 17 Christians visiting from Puerto Rico. Another 80 were injured in the attack.

Twitter fury after British Airways loses entire flights worth of luggage



There's only one thing more frustrating than losing your bag when you're off on holiday - the entire plane of passengers losing their luggage, too. That's the reality today for hundreds of passengers whose luggage was left behind at Heathrow. "How does [sic] British Airways lose a whole plane load of luggage from Heathrow to Bologna!" One disgruntled passenger wrote. He continued: "The whole plane BA0540 apparently left at Heathrow or put on another plane."

Boeing to take a \$4.9 billion charge over grounded jet



Boeing said Thursday it is booking a \$4.9 billion charge to cover possible compensation to airlines that have canceled thousands of flights since the 737 Max jet was grounded after two deadly accidents. The airplane builder also said the Max-related fallout will cut \$5.6 billion from its revenue and pre-tax earnings in the April-through-June quarter. The Chicago-based company said the calculations were based on an assumption that regulatory approval for the plane's return to flying will begin early in the fourth quarter.

Palace says Duterte can declare martial law if terrorism reaches Metro Manila

Presidential Spokesperson Salvador Panelo said the chief executive expressed concern about the recent suicide bombing which led to the death of eight individuals including one [Filipino suicide bomber](#) in Indanan, Sulu. That's what he feared, there is already a suicide bomber. He's very concerned of that. So he warned the enemies of the state. 'Don't force my hand into it. I will not allow the disintegration of this country,' he said.



Indiana Brothers Charged With Manufacturing Arms for ISIS

Two Indiana brothers have been charged with manufacturing illegal weapons and selling them to ISIS. [Moyad Dannon, 21, and Mahde Dannon, 20](#), both of Fishers, Indiana, were arrested on May 15, 2019 after a months-long covert investigation led by the FBI's Joint Terrorism Task Force. Prosecutors say Mahde, who was awaiting trial on felony theft charges in Lake County, Indiana, hatched a scheme to deliver firearms, including stolen firearms, to a convicted felon. The felon was covertly cooperating with the FBI. First Mahde introduced the felon to his brother Moyad. The felon then introduced both brothers to an undercover FBI agent posing to be an arms dealer for ISIS.



Islamists in Canada Poised to Grab Anti-Racism Jackpot

The Canadian government recently [unveiled](#) a new anti-racism strategy that dedicates \$45 million to fight systemic discrimination through community programs, public education campaigns and combating online hate. While it's good to combat racism and bigotry at every level, this particular anti-racism strategy is based on key recommendations that came from the anti-[Islamophobia](#) motion M103. When Motion M103 was first introduced in Canada by MP Iqra Khalid, we were among the individuals and organizations that expressed concern about use of the term "[Islamophobia](#)."



JetBlue flight evacuated at Newark Airport after suicide vest photo AirDropped to passenger iPhones

A plane was evacuated after someone sent a photograph of a suicide vest to passengers and flight attendants on board. The unknown sender used [Apple's AirDrop](#) feature, which allows users to easily and anonymously transfer files to other iOS devices using [Bluetooth](#). Authorities say the Florida-bound plane was about to take off from Newark Liberty International Airport in New Jersey when the image was widely shared on board. A member of the crew on [JetBlue](#) flight 573 alerted the captain, who informed authorities at about 7.45am on Saturday. The plane returned to the gate and the 150 people on board were asked to leave the aircraft, and their luggage was re-screened and examined by police bomb-sniffing K-9 dogs.
