| Course Title : CHECKPOINT SCREENER X-RAY CERTIFICATION COURSE | |
| <p>Course Purpose:</p> <p>This course is to meet ICAO Annex 17, Std 3.4.3 which requires Contracting States to ensure that the persons carrying out screening operations are certified according to the requirements of the national civil aviation security programme to ensure that performance standards are consistently and reliably achieved.</p> <p>This course provides fundamentals related to the detection of security threats for new and existing security checkpoint x-ray screeners to complement on-the-job training. Using a computer-based simulation system (Safe Passage) that is able to simulate most of the major x-ray machines, participants get an opportunity to practice their x-ray image interpretation and threat identification skills in the safety and comfort of a classroom. Course materials comply with ICAO, EC 185/2010 and EC 300/2008 regulations and are taught by certified instructors.</p> | |

- Certify staff in their field of specialization (baggage or cargo screening)
- Identification of explosives materials, IEDs, prohibited, restricted and other threat items
- Learning the importance of discovery protocols
- Pre board screening operations
- Understanding Supply Chain security concepts for cargo and mail
- Certify staff as x-ray screeners through CBT -based testing that requires them to apply threat detection methodologies and image interpretation skills
