Course Title : <b>CREATING AN AVSEC CULTURE</b>	
Course Purpose:  This course is to meet ICAO Annex 17, Std 3.1.6 which requires Contracting State to establish a national aviation security committee or similar arrangements for the purpose of coordinating security activities between the departments, agencies and other organizations of the State, airport and aircraft operators, air traffic service providers and other entities concerned with or responsible for the implementation of various aspects of the national civil aviation security programme.  Security culture is an organizational culture that encourages optimal security performance. The establishment of security culture should assist organisations in improving their overall security performance through the early identification of potential security challenges. This course would equip you with the knowledge of Security Culture and Security Management Systems (SeMS) for the effective implementation and establishment of security culture within your organisation.	
Target Population:  This course is beneficial to personnel responsible for AVSEC operations and management from civil aviation administrations, airport authorities, airlines and AVSEC related agencies.
