#### Hong Kong Customs Seizes More Than 3 Tonnes Of Illegal Drugs

Hong Kong customs at the airport seized more than three tonnes of illegal drugs valued at over HK\$1.3 billion (US\$166 million) in the first seven months of this year, marking an increase of nearly 20 per cent from the whole of 2022, the Post has learned. The massive haul was also about 120 per cent more than the 1.4 tonnes of narcotics worth HK\$630 million uncovered in cargo consignments and on passengers at the airport in the same period last year, a law enforcement source on Thursday revealed.



### A Muslim Social Media Personality Says He Was Forced To Strip Naked By Airport Security

A Muslim influencer went viral on TikTok after saying he was strip-searched at Ben Gurion Airport. An airport staff member scolded him for holding up the United Airlines flight with 300 passengers for 30 minutes. He told Insider that the security incident flared up "childhood traumas of sexual abuse." New York-based <a href="@wayoflifesq.official">@wayoflifesq.official</a> — who did not wish to reveal his real name — has over a million YouTube subscribers and nearly a million followers combined on TikTok and Instagram.



### Air New Zealand Passenger Removed From Flight In Auckland For Security Risk

Passengers on an Air New Zealand flight to Samoa experienced a four-hour delay due to a misconstrued threatening comment made by a passenger. All passengers were required to disembark the aircraft and go through additional security screening, causing the delay. Although it was later determined that the comment was a misunderstanding, airlines take safety concerns seriously and appreciate passengers' cooperation in resolving such matters.

#### Shots Fired At Kapan Airport From The Territory Of Azerbaijan

On the night of August 18, an unknown person who came to the area adjacent to "Syunik" airport of Kapan in Syunik province on the Armenia-Azerbaijani border line in an unidentified vehicle fired three shots in the direction of the airport and escaped. The National Security Service (NSS) of Armenia reports that two bullets damaged one of the windows and the roof of the airport. Earlier, **Mediamax** reported that Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan travelled to Syunik province on Yerevan-Kapan flight and familiarized himself with the conditions of the "Syunik" airport.



#### **Drugs Seized At Anegada Airport**

Police on the British Virgin Islands made a major drug bust on Anegada yesterday. Details of the drug bust, which occurred at the Auguste George Airport, were not revealed by police but they said it occurred after a joint operation with the United States. "An airplane and a significant amount of what is believed to be cocaine were seized in the operation. The investigation remains active therefore no further information will be made available at this time," the Royal British Virgin Islands Police Force said in statement.



#### Woman Arrested At Phnom Penh Airport For Fraud

A woman was dramatically arrested at Phnom Penh International Airport on charges of "fraud and forgery of public documents" – and police are searching for her husband in connection with the same charges. On August 19, 2023, the light criminal bureau of the Criminal Police Department arrested Chea Sophalla, Female, 42 years old, Nationality Khmer, Occupation Trader, Address: House 5 (New World Borey, Samrong Andet), Street 1, Sangkat Kork Khleang, Khan Sen Sok, Phnom Penh at Phnom Penh International Airport on charges of fraud, forgery of public documents and use of public documents under Articles 377, 378, 629 and 630 of the Penal Code in Phnom Penh on November 6, 2021.
