Gardaí Seize Heroin Worth €8m After Intercepting Plane At

Weston Airport

Gardaí national officials have seized heroin worth €8 million after intercepting a light aircraft at Weston Airport in Dublin. Two men, aged in their 40s and 60s, were arrested on suspicion of organised crime activity after the drugs were found on Friday morning. Weston Airport is located 13km west of Dublin city centre, between Lucan and Leixlip, Co Kildare. Revenue and the Garda National Drugs and Organised Crime Bureau carried out the operation. Garda Assistant Commissioner Justin Kelly said law enforcement agencies are seeing a global increase in the use of non-commercial flights to smuggle drugs.



Record Amount of Drugs Seized at Kansai Airport

Two men living in Saitama Prefecture have been arrested on suspicion of smuggling methamphetamine from Mexico, the Narcotics Control Department of Kinki Regional Bureau of Health and Welfare and Osaka Customs' Kansai Airport Branch Customs have announced. Approximately 30 kilograms of methamphetamine was seized at Kansai Airport, with a street value of about ¥1.844 billion. This marks the largest seizure at the airport since its opening in 1994. The arrested individuals are a company executive, 34 and a truck driver, 32, according to the announcement. They are believed to have conspired with other suspects, who are still at large, to smuggle methamphetamine in violation of laws including the Stimulants Control Law. The two men are accused of transporting the drugs in a piece of machinery from Mexico to Kansai Airport via Hong Kong, using a cargo flight on July 3. Neither of the two has a history of traveling to Mexico. Authorities are investigating whether an organized smuggling group may have been involved.

A woman has been detained in [Moscow](#) after allegedly giving oral sex to a male stranger sitting next to her on a tourist flight from Antalya. Passengers and crew clapped and cheered when police came on board and detained the woman, named Valeria, 29, at Vnukovo airport in the Russian capital. The alleged sexual encounter happened on a five-hour Pobeda Airlines flight, with children among the passengers.



22 November 2023 GACA Strengthens Passenger Protection Regulations

The new regulations are designed to create a better travel experience, providing greater support at each stage of the passenger's journey in the event of travel disruptions. GACA has initiated the "Putting Passengers First" consumer education campaign to educate passengers on their strengthened protections, and the importance of contacting their airline to use their rights in the event of a disruption.
